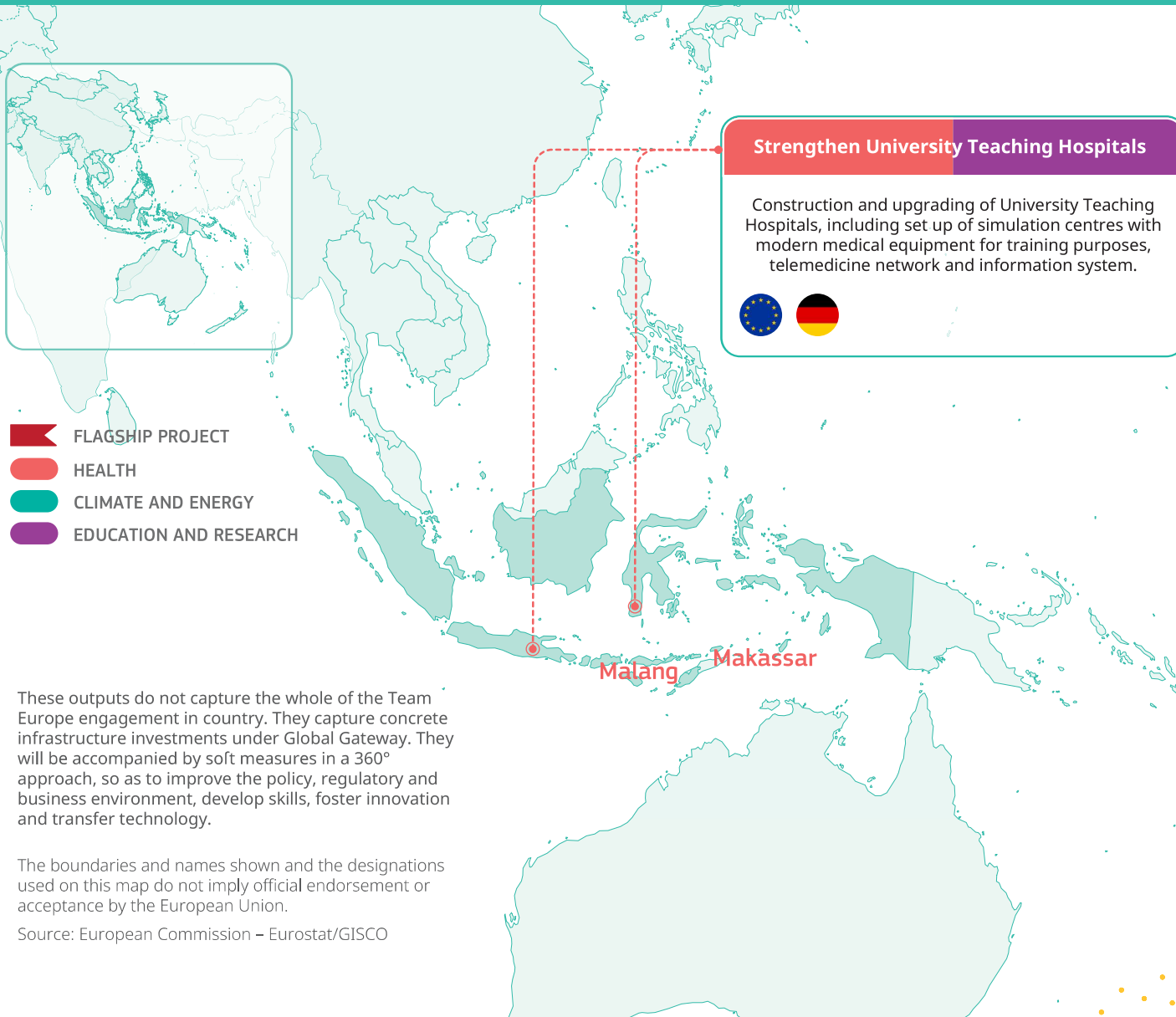

Strengthen University Teaching Hospitals

Construction and upgrading of University Teaching Hospitals, including set up of simulation centres with modern medical equipment for training purposes, telemedicine network and information system.

Indonesia JETP

Contribution to the Indonesia-International Partners Group Just Energy Transition Partnership (JETP) to expand renewable energies and phase down on- and off-grid coal-fired electricity generation.

Indonesia Policy Dialogue Fund (IPDF)

Mobilisation of Policy Loans by International Development Finance Institutions in key areas such as clean energy and marine debris.

SDG Indonesia One

Financing of infrastructure projects with climate and SDG benefits through the SDG One platform, with a focus on increasing the bankability of small renewable energy projects.

Support for Infrastructure Investments (S4I)

Support to subnational governments' access to finance for environmental, productive and social infrastructure.

They will be accompanied by soft measures in a 360° approach, so as to improve the policy, regulatory and business environment, develop skills, foster innovation and transfer technology.
