

## New EU Ambassador to Fiji Presents his Credentials

Ambassador Seam underlined that our close to 46 years of friendship with Fiji has helped solidify our shared interests, values, security and prosperity.

Ambassador Seam represents the Presidents of the European Commission and the European Council, under the authority of the High Representative for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy. Ambassador Seam is a French citizen. He is married to Jane Seam and they have moved to Fiji with their two children.
