### 歐洲投資計劃:歐洲基金戰略性投資延長至 2018 之後 Investment Plan for Europe: European Fund for Strategic Investments to be extended beyond 2018



On 1 June, the EU presented a proposal for the future of the European Fund for Strategic Investments (EFSI). Since its launch, the EFSI has raised €100 billion worth of investments for the EU economy every day. A reinforced EFSI will continue beyond the initial three-year period. The European Commission will present legislative proposals in the autumn to extend the duration of the EFSI.

<u>歐盟對北韓採取新限制</u> EU adopts new restrictions against North Korea

On 26-27 May, the EU attended the G7 Summit hosted by Japan. The summit focused on the global economy, foreign policy and the migration and refugee crisis. In the margins of the summit the EU, France, Germany, Italy and the United Kingdom issued a joint statement on the EU-Japan Economic Partnership Agreement known as the Free Trade Agreement. The statement reiterates a commitment to a free, fair and open international trade and economic system which will provide a sustainable and balanced economic growth in Japan and the EU.

EU relations with DPRK

On 27 May, the EU adopted additional restrictive measures against the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK). Considering that the actions of the DPRK constitute a grave threat to international peace and security in the region and beyond, the EU decided to further expand its restrictive measures targeting the DPRK's nuclear, weapons of mass destruction and ballistic missile programmes. The additional measures concern trade, financial, investment and transport sectors.

<u>Code of Conduct</u>

On 31 May, the EU together with the IT companies such as Facebook, Twitter, YouTube and Microsoft agreed upon a Code of Conduct against illegal online hate speech. The IT companies committed to putting in place clear and effective processes to review notifications regarding illegal hate speech on their services so they can remove or disable access to such content. Also, the IT companies and the European Commission, recognising the value of independent counter speech against hateful rhetoric and prejudice, will continue their work in identifying and promoting independent counternarratives, new ideas and initiatives and supporting educational programs that encourage critical thinking.
