EU-funded scholarships for Thais to study, teach or do research in Europe

What's Erasmus+?

Erasmus+ is the European Union programme for education, training, youth and sport for the period 2014 - 2020. It offers a range of opportunities for higher education students, doctoral candidates, staff and institutions from around the world.

What types of scholarships are available?

+ 1. Erasmus+ Credit Mobility: Study part of your degree in Europe

Since 2015 Thai higher education institutions (HEIs) have been able to set up mobility agreements with HEIs in the European Union. If your university has one or more inter-institutional agreements, you will be able to apply to spend part of your degree period (3 to 12 months) at the European university. Your academic activities abroad will be fully recognised and will count towards your degree once you come back to Thailand. This mobility is possible at bachelor, master or doctorate level.

How much is the scholarship?

Thai students coming to Europe may receive a monthly contribution to their expenses abroad of between EUR 750 and EUR 850, depending on the cost of living in the host country, plus a travel contribution based on the distance from the home to the host institution.

When and how can you apply?

Contact the international relations office of your university to enquire directly.

+ 2. Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees: Follow an entire degree in Europe

Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees (EMJMDs) are operated by consortia of higher education institutions (HEIs) from the EU and elsewhere in the world. They provide high quality integrated courses and joint or multiple diplomas following study or research at two or more HEIs. They offer EU-funded scholarships or fellowships to:

Graduates to study in an EMJMD

Scholars and guest academics to teach or carry out research as part of an EMJMD

Students and doctoral candidates from all over the world are eligible to apply.

How much is the scholarship?

The scholarship covers the participation, travel and installation, subsistence and insurance costs. Altogether this can amount to up to EUR 25 000 per year

When and how can you apply?

Apply directly to the consortium. Application procedures and deadlines vary between courses. The application period is between October and January every year. Visit the EMJMDs catalogue at <http://europa.eu/lbb83HW>

Are you interested in spending part of your study or research period at bachelors, masters or doctorate level in Europe?

Are you a current student or scholar at a higher education institution that has Erasmus+ cooperation agreements with European universities?

IF YOUR ANSWER IS 'YES' TO THE QUESTIONS ABOVE, YOU CAN BENEFIT FROM...

- ▶ applying for a scholarship for short-term Erasmus + credit mobility (3 to 12 months) and spend part of your study period at a European host institution
- ▶ the full recognition of the academic activities at the European host institution which contribute to your degree once you return to your home institution

HOW TO APPLY?



#1: Enquire

Contact the international relations office within your own university to see if it has Erasmus+ agreements.



#2: Find the right course

Ask this department for a list of courses open for students under Erasmus + to find a course you might be interested in.



#4: Result

Once the selection process is finalised your institution will communicate the results



#3: Apply for the course

Depending on your institution, either your international relations office or your own faculty will help you prepare your application within the right timeframe.



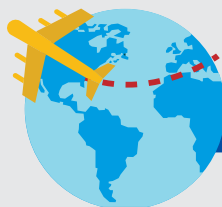
#6: Erasmus+ Pre-departure Reception

ERASMUS MUNDUS JOINT MASTER DEGREES

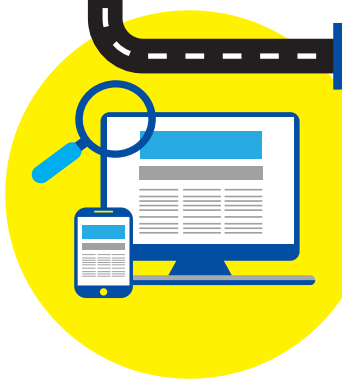
Are you a graduate who is interested in following an entire Master degree in Europe?

IF YOUR ANSWER IS 'YES' TO THE QUESTION ABOVE, YOU CAN BENEFIT FROM...

- ▶ applying for a scholarship to follow an **Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree**. Each programme is offered by a consortium of European and often non-European higher education institutions.
- ▶ studying in at least two of the participating institutions and receiving a joint or double/multiple degree at the end of your studies.
- ▶ scholarships covering the participation costs, travel to Europe, a living allowance and insurance during the study period.

HOW TO APPLY?

#1: Find the right course & apply



You must apply directly to the consortium. Visit the EMJMDs catalogue at http://eacea.ec.europa.eu/erasmus_mundus/funding/scholarships_students_academics_en.php to find over 100 Masters programmes offering Erasmus + scholarships.

ATTENTION! Application procedures and deadline vary between courses. Visit a programme's website for more information on the courses and the online application procedures.

Most consortia will open their application procedure in the fourth quarter of the calendar year for programmes starting in the next academic year.



#3: Visa / Student residence permit

After receiving an official letter confirming your admission from the consortium, you can start applying for a visa or student residence permit (for Thai citizens)

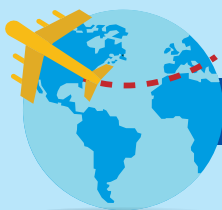
The application result will be sent to you directly by the consortium.

+ 3. Other opportunities: Erasmus Mundus Partnerships

You may also apply to one of the Erasmus Mundus Partnerships to engage in the mobility of human resources ranging from:

- Undergraduates
- Post-doctoral research fellows
- Masters students
- Academic or administrative staff
- PhD candidates

Grants are available for:

- candidates registered at one of the partner universities
- candidates who are registered at - or graduate of - other universities

How much is the grant?

The grant covers all participation costs, travel and insurance, plus a monthly allowance of at least EUR 1000 per month.

When and how can you apply?

Apply direct to the partnership for which you are eligible. Each partnership lists the programmes on offer. Please consult the website of the Erasmus Mundus Partnership that interests you for details of timetables, entry requirements and application procedures.
