DIGITAL

Key goals:

- Strengthen digital partnership e.g. via submarine cables and satellite networks
- Promote fast and effective roll-out of 5G, with support for rural development, health care and precision agriculture
- Improve cross-border payments, including remittances, digitalisation of payments
- Protection of personal data and privacy
- Satellite-based emergency warning services in the domain of space-based data and technology

- CITIIS (City Investments to Innovate, Integrate and Sustain) support for implementation of the India Smart Cities Mission [EU, FR]

ENERGY

Key goals:

- Support for renewable energy, underpinned by modernised and efficient and smart electricity systems
- Promotion of energy efficiency and renewables investments, including offshore (and coastal) wind energy
- Engaging public and private sector stakeholders to support offshore wind energy deployment
- Support for the International Solar Alliance

- Eco-Cities (Mumbai, Bengaluru, Pune, Chennai, Bhubaneswar, including public lighting, waste to energy, rooftop solar) [EU]
- EIB-IREDA Renewable Energy & Energy Efficiency Loans [EU]

- Promote interconnection of transport corridors, including through cooperation on railways
- Dialogue on Smart and Sustainable Mobility
- Promote economically and ecologically sustainable air transport
- Cooperate at ICAO and IMO on greenhouse gas reduction
- Identify potential joint investments in port sector, alternative fuels

Key goals:

- Scientific research and innovation, technology and skills
- Capacity building and mobility actions of researchers.
- Support for European and Indian innovation ecosystem, targeting SMEs and startups
- Promote student and faculty mobility between EU and Indian Higher Education Institutions (HEIs)
- Increased Horizon Europe (2021-2027) actions on mobility, networking and connectivity projects for green and digital transition

- Erasmus+ with over 2800 Indian students and staff coming to Europe and 1400 Europeans to India (2014-2020) [EU]
