

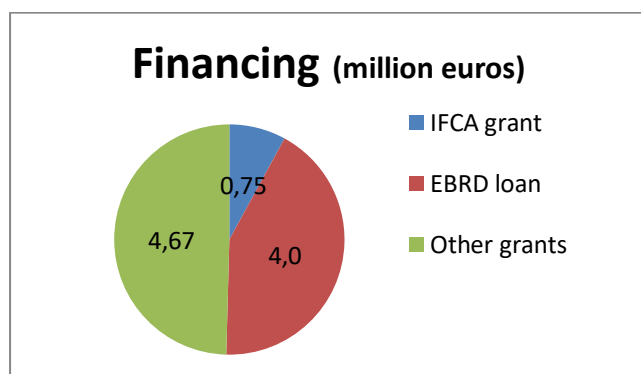
# Jalal Abad water project

## Program Development Objective

The Jalal Abad water project aims at improving the availability, reliability and quality of municipal infrastructure. Also, it focuses on the commercialization of water supply and sanitation in order to ensure operational and financial sustainability once the project is completed.



A total of 9,42 million euros were invested to address the infrastructure and rehabilitation needs in the water sector in Jalal Abad.

## Beneficiaries

94,600 people are currently serviced by the water companies; their number is predicted to increase to 226,000 after the project implementation.

## Project's activities:

- Reconstruction of a large waste water treatment plan
- Modernisation of a smaller waste water treatment plan
- Metering operations
- Maintenance equipment

## Expected outcomes

- The number of people with access to affordable, drinking tap water will increase from 94,600 to 226,000;
- Implementation of new or rehabilitated water supply pipes and sewage system;
- Reduction of water production
- Reduction of CO2
- Reduction of water borne diseases.
- Environmental and Social Action Plan (ESAP) is implemented;
