Movie Competition

Climate change is a direct threat. It spares no country and requires a collective response. The fight against climate change is one of the top priorities of the European Union. The European Union Delegation in Port Moresby is strongly supporting Papua New Guinea to tackle climate change.

In the framework of the Climate Diplomacy weeks to be held from 23rd September to 6th October, the European Union Delegation to Papua New Guinea is organising a Movie competition for PNG university students.

Indeed, the impact of climate change on Papua New Guinea is such that the World's first climate refugees are in one of its island. Solutions need to be implemented quickly to tackle this global issue.

Competition Rules and Guidelines:

- The theme of the movie is: "Concrete solutions to reverse climate change in Papua New Guinea."
- The competition is open to any student currently enrolled in any university in Papua New Guinea.
- The participating student will present a movie (duration: minimum 3 minutes; maximum =4 minutes) on a flash drive. Subtitles in English are requested if the movie is done in other languages.
- The movie must be accompanied by a letter explaining the meaning of it in no more than 500 words in English.
- A photocopy of the student university ID card must be included with the entry.
- Entries are limited to 1 movie per student.
- The movies must be delivered by Friday 20 September at 16:00. Movies arriving after the closing date will not be considered.
- The jury will do a preselection of up to 2 movies by 25 September on the merits of quality, originality, creativity, translation of the theme.
- The public will have the opportunity to vote (only by liking the movie on the PNG European Union Facebook page) from 26 September 9:00 am until 30 September 09:00 (PNG local time).
- The winning movie will be the one which will have received the greater number of "Like" on the PNG European Union Delegation Facebook page by 30 September 09:00 (PNG local time).
- Prize: the European Union Delegation to Papua New Guinea will offer a '32GB iPad Air 2' tablet to the winning student.
- By submitting entries participants understand that (in participating) the copyright of the movie will be retained by the European Union. Appropriate credit to the student will apply i.e. Movie made by: (Named) and Copyright: EU.
- Entries must be marked: "Climate Diplomacy week 2019 Movie Competition" and be submitted to the Delegation of the European Union in Papua New Guinea, Post Office 76, Port Moresby and or delivered to the ground floor foyer of BSP HAUS, Harbour City to the designated personnel.
- Contestants are responsible to ensure that any parties filmed have given their permission to be filmed and that they (the filmmaker) are responsible for any dispute over intellectual property rights of the entry submitted to the contest.
