

EU COVID-19 Rapid Response Support to Myanmar Myan Ku Emergency Cash Fund

Garment. Textiles & Footwear Sector

April - December 2020

Myan Ku "Quick Assistance" Fund

is a €5 million (7.9 billion kyat) rapid response cash fund to support the mostly female garment workers from across Myanmar who have lost their jobs due to the COVID-19 crisis. Quick and unbureaucratic cash payments will help workers pay for food and avoid evictions.

80%"Workers in crisis"

fund to support garment workers who either are jobless or demonstrate evidence of eviction.





At least **30,000** and up to **80,000** workers supported with emergency cash transfers averaging **75,000 kyat** per each month support for an estimated period of 1 to 3 months.

10% "Illegal termination support" fund to provide cash transfers to workers with evidence of illegal termination.





8,000 workers supported with emergency cash transfers of **125,000 kyat.**

10% "Workforce retention support" fund to provide cash

support fund to provide cash transfers to workers for SMEs who agree to retain workers and agree to provide at least matching support.





Approximately **5,000** workers supported from factories that provide their workers with matching cash or in-kind support like free accommodation and meals.
