

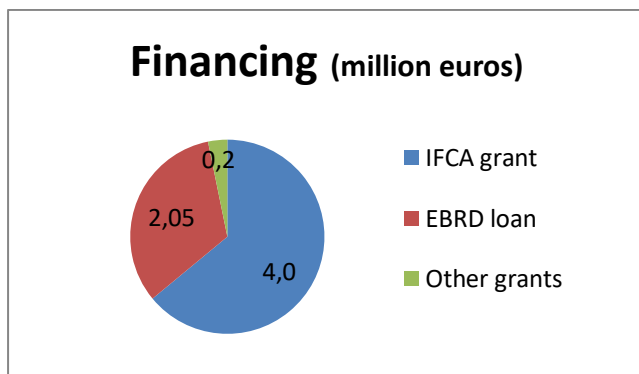
Myrza-Ake, Kurshab, Don Bulak water project

Program Development Objective

The European Union is providing support to the Myrza Ake, Kushab and Don-Bulak localities to rehabilitate water supply services and selected wastewater improvements. Investments are expected to significantly improve infrastructure in the water system, reduce water losses, and optimise operating costs for the Water Companies of these localities.



A total of 6,25 million euros were invested to address the infrastructure and rehabilitation needs in the water sector in Myrza Ake, Kushab and Don-Bulak.

Beneficiaries

12,500 people are currently serviced by the water companies in Myrza Ake, Kushab and Don-Bulak cities; the quality of service is predicted to serve 34,000 people after the project implementation.

Project's activities:

- Replacement of water networks, including installation of control valves, fire hydrants.
- Improving resilience to climate change
- Building sterilisation, chlorination equipment and sanitary protection

- Installation of metering operation systems
- Installation of maintenance equipment

Location



Expected outcomes

- The number of people with access to affordable, drinking tap water will increase from 12,500 to 34,000;
- Implementation of an individual metering system for each household and of a metering based billing;
- Reduction of CO2 derived from reduction in water losses at system level.
