**Ruth Simsa** is Professor of Sociology at the Department for Socioeconomics at WU Wien (Vienna University of Economics and Business). She is Editor-in-Chief of VOLUNTAS International Journal of Voluntary and Nonprofit Organisations and until 2018 was scientific director of WU's Competence Centre for Nonprofit Organisations and Social Entrepreneurship. Her research focuses on civil society, nonprofit organisations and social movement organisations.



**Edith Archambault** academic career was mainly at the University Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne. She chaired the Lab of Social Economy and was the Dean of the Department of Economics. She is now professor emerita. Her research fields are national accounting, and the economics of associations, foundations and volunteering. She was an associate of the Johns Hopkins International Comparison of the Non-profit Sector Programme. She was a founding member of the International Society for Third Sector Research.



**Viacheslav Bakhmin** is an expert on philanthropy and civil society development in Russia and co-chair of the Moscow Helsinki Group and chairman of the Sakharov Centre. He served as the Head of the International Humanitarian and Cultural Cooperation Directorate in the Ministry for Foreign Affairs from 1991 to 1995. He was Executive Director of the Open Society Institute (OSI) in Russia between 1995 and 2003. He also worked as a manager of the Swiss Human Rights programme and as a consultant for the Ford Foundation and the C.S. Mott Foundation.



**Brian Harvey** is an independent social researcher working in the fields of poverty, social exclusion, equality, community development, human rights, the world of non-governmental organisations and European integration. He is based in Dublin and works for voluntary and community organisations, government agencies, inter-governmental bodies and trusts and foundations in both parts of Ireland, Britain and continental Europe.



**Nick Acheson** is a retired professional and academic. He was Visiting Research Fellow at the Centre for Social Innovation, Trinity College Dublin from 2015 to 2020 and lectured in Social Policy at Ulster University from 1997 to 2015. He served as co-editor of the scholarly journal, Voluntary Sector Review, an International Journal of Third Sector Research, Policy and Practice from 2015 to 2018. He is currently a member of the research team for a UK national research project on mobilising voluntary action in the time of COVID-19.
