## Location



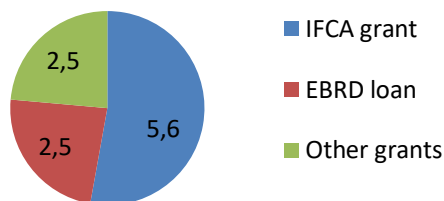
## Program Development Objective

The European Union provides support to the City of Uzgen to rehabilitate water supply services and selected wastewater improvements in the City. Investments are expected to significantly improve infrastructure in the water system, reduce water losses, and optimise operating costs for the Uzgen Water Company.

## Expected outcomes

- The number of people with access to affordable, drinking tap water will be 48,000;
- Implementation of an individual metering system for each household and of a metering based billing;
- Reduction of CO2 derived from reduction in water losses at system level.

## Financing (million euros)



A total of 10,6 million euros were invested to address the infrastructure and rehabilitation needs in the water sector in Uzgen.

## Beneficiaries

30,700 people are currently serviced by the water companies; their number is predicted to increase to 48,000.

## Project's activities:

- Improving basic water infrastructure and access to services for the population
- Improving resilience to climate change
- Eliminate health risks posed by unreliable water supply and unsanitary wastewater handling
