### General Aim of Project:

The aim of the current project is strengthening youth's capacity and use of information and communication technology in climate change governance, resilience and contribution to the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals.

### Specific objectives of project:

- Youth and women engaged in multi-stakeholder communications on climate change adaptation issues;
- Climate Change Learning and Education for Sustainable Development established into the education system with new tools and technologies;
- Best practices for tackling climate change established with local multi-actor partnerships in 6 selected rural communities in pilot oblasts;

### Main target groups:

Women's and youth, activists of human rights and environmental network of grassroots organizations, in all regions of the Kyrgyz Republic, young representatives in local authorities, mass media, journalists and bloggers, young teachers at universities, young scientists, Higher education institutions of pedagogical and scientific profile, decision-makers and policy makers at the national and local levels.

### Project Output

- Multi-sectoral online platform "Innovation for Climate Hub" is developed and is actively used by the civil society.
- Youth and women are involved in public dialogue on «Country Strategy for Climate Change Adaptation» and "Voluntary Climate Contributions", in relation to the achievement of the SDGs.
- Youth groups and civil society organizations working on sustainable development are trained on strategic communications.
- Pedagogical Universities in Kyrgyzstan have new interdisciplinary academic modules on CC tackling theory, mitigation and adaptation actions, communities' mobilization, social responsibility and sustainable development.
- Various continuous education electronic courses on CC issues for teachers, including those in Kyrgyz language are available.
- Students have access to high-quality electronic informative and educational tools on climate change issues.
- Climate-related sustainability strategies and CC adaptation plans have been tested in 6 local communities.
- Establishment of alternative ecologically-friendly forms of income generation.
- Youth and women's groups from the communities can develop meaningful, appropriate recommendations for local government bodies on climate change adaptation and monitor the implementation and the decisions made.



### Expected Impact:

- Informed youth with potential will be able to act as a partner for government and society as a whole in adaptation to climate change, will have the opportunity to socialize as climate leaders, will become visible at the level of development and adoption of strategies and NDC and SDG, which ultimately will lead to better and more ambitious decisions on issues contributing to "climate change resilience".
