2 Requirements

Graduated at least High School with Europe Union recognized Diploma, with at least 5 years working experience in management filed at operational and international level.

At least SLP (Standard Language Profile) 3333 level of English language (*).

Leadership is essential.

Ability to perform activities under stressful conditions.

Education/training in Service/Army/Other Government Departments is highly recommended.

3 Responsibilities

Overseeing and managing Role2 personnel.

Identifying requirements and providing resources, as appropriate.

Ensuring that the daily medical activities are operated in accordance with applicable (International) Law and EU standards"

1 | Position: Medical Doctor, General Surgeon Specialist

2 Requirements

Graduated at State University with Europe Union recognized Degree, with at least 5 years working experience in surgery filed.

At least English SLP (Standard Language Profile or STANAG 6001) 2222 level (*).

Operational and International Experience.

Team worker. Ability to perform activities under stressful conditions.

Wide experience in work with different kind of diseases and patients; education/training in Service/Army/Other Government Departments Medical Corps and command experience is highly recommended.

3 Responsibilities

Evaluating a trauma victim, institutes immediate therapy, helps with operative management, follows the patient through critical care and surgical recovery and handles outpatient care:

Providing Damage Control Surgery, Primary Surgery and Emergency Life Saving Surgery;

Assisting in Emergency Orthopedic Surgery;

Diagnosing, preoperative, operative, and postoperative management, including the management of complications;

Completing care of critically patients with underlying surgical conditions in the intensive care unit;

Making sure that patients understand the surgical procedure about to undertake;

Performing operations under stressful conditions, in which the correct decisions need to be made quickly;

Handling a broad range of procedures including orthopedic, head & neck, thoracic and urologic services, in some cases;

Completing and monitors the entire medical records of injured and sick;

Coordinating daily activities with Role 2 Manager and EUTM-S JMed;

Being on call 24/7 for emergencies;

Acting Chief of Role 2 in the absence of Role 2 Manager.

1 | Position: Medical Doctor, Orthopedic Surgeon Specialist

2 Requirements

Graduated at State University with Europe Union recognized Degree, with at least 5 years working experience in orthopedic filed.

At least English SLP (Standard Language Profile or STANAG 6001) 2222 level (*).

Operational and International Experience. Team worker. Ability to perform activities under stressful conditions.

Wide experience in work with different kind of diseases and patients; education/training in Service/Army/Other Government Departments Medical Corps and command experience is highly recommended.

3 Responsibilities

Evaluating a trauma victim, institutes immediate therapy, helps with operative management, follows the patient through critical care and surgical recovery and handles outpatient care;

Carrying out surgery that deals with bones, muscles and tendons;

Carrying out tests such as physical examinations and x-rays to learn the extent of patient injuries;

Collating, analyzing and updating patient records to ensure they are offered the best treatment and care;

Discussing treatment methods with patients to make sure they are okay to go ahead with treatment:

Performing operations under stressful conditions, in which the correct decisions need to be made quickly;

Providing Damage Control Surgery, Primary Surgery, Emergency Orthopedic Surgery;

Assistance in Emergency Life Saving Surgery;

Completing care of critically patients with underlying surgical conditions in the intensive care unit;

Being on call 24/7 for medical emergencies;

In absence of General Surgeon, coordinate daily activities with Role 2 Manager and EUTM-S JMed.

Position: Medical Doctor, Anesthesiology Specialist

2 Requirements

Graduated at State University with Europe Union recognized Degree, with at least 5 years working experience in anesthesiology filed. At least English SLP (Standard Language Profile or STANAG 6001) 2222 level (*).

Operational and International Experience. Team worker. Ability to perform activities under stressful conditions.

Wide experience in work with different kind of diseases and patients; education/training in Service/Army/Other Government Departments Medical Corps and command experience is highly recommended.

3 Responsibilities

Administering anesthetic or sedation during medical procedures, using local, intravenous, spinal, or caudal methods;

Monitoring patient before, during, and after anesthesia and counteract adverse reactions or complications;

Providing and maintaining life support and airway management and help prepare patients for emergency surgery;

Recording type and amount of anesthesia and patient condition throughout procedure:

Examining patient, obtaining medical history, and using of diagnostic tests to determine risk during surgical procedures;

Positioning patient on operating table to maximize patient comfort and surgical accessibility;

Deciding when patients have recovered or stabilized enough to be sent to another room or ward or to be sent home following outpatient surgery;

Coordinating administration of anesthetics with surgeons during operation;

Coordinating and direct work of nurses, medical technicians, and other health care providers;

Ordering laboratory tests, x-rays, and other diagnostic procedures;

Managing anesthesiological services, coordinating them with other medical activities and formulating plans and procedures;

Performing activities under stressful conditions, in which the correct decisions need to be made quickly;

Being on call 24/7 for medical emergencies.

1 | Position: Anesthetic Nurse

2 Requirements

Graduated at Medical High School with Europe Union recognized Diploma, with at least 5 years working experience in anesthetic filed. At least English SLP (Standard Language Profile or STANAG 6001) 1111 level (*).

Operational and International Experience. Team worker. Ability to perform activities under stressful conditions.

Wide experience in work with different kind of diseases and patients; education/training in Service/Army/Other Government Departments Medical Corps is highly recommended.

3 Responsibilities

Selecting and prescribing post-anesthesia medications or treatments to patients;

Administering post-anesthesia medications or fluids to support patients' cardiovascular systems;

Evaluating patients' post-surgical or post-anesthesia responses, taking appropriate corrective actions or requesting consultation if complications occur;

Performing pre-anesthetic screenings, including physical evaluations and patient interviews, and document results;

Selecting, ordering or administering pre-anesthetic medications and discharge patients from post-anesthesia care;

Performing or evaluate the results of diagnostic tests such as radiographs (x-rays) and electrocardiograms (EKGs);

Managing patients' airway or pulmonary status using techniques such as endotracheal intubation, mechanical ventilation, pharmacological support, respiratory therapy and extubating;

Monitoring patients' responses, including skin color, pupil dilation, pulse, heart rate, blood pressure and respiration, ventilation, or urine output, using invasive and non-invasive techniques;

Fulfilling other orders by a physician in order to improve the patient's health or save the life of the wounded and injured.

1 | Position: Critical Care Nurse

2 Requirements

Graduated at Medical High School with Europe Union recognized Diploma, with at least 5 years working experience in critical care filed. At least English SLP (Standard Language Profile or STANAG 6001) 1111 level (*).

Operational and International Experience. Team worker. Ability to perform activities under stressful conditions.

Wide experience in work with different kind of diseases and patients; education/training in Service/Army/Other Government Departments Medical Corps is highly recommended.

3 Responsibilities

Providing pre- and post-operation care; Responsible for total patient care, including medication, orders and treatments;

Assisting the physician with procedures and treatments. Administering treatments including sterile procedures;

Observing and recording patient vital signs;

Performing the techniques of cardiopulmonary resuscitation accurately and effectively;

Ensuring that ventilators, monitors and other types of medical equipment function properly;

Monitoring and administering medication and intravenous infusions;

Treating wounds and providing advanced life support;

Taking patient samples, pulses, temperatures and blood pressures;

Practicing economical use of equipment and supplies;

Maintaining the patient's clinical records; assisting with execution of the physician's orders;

Owing medical equipment (apparatus and instruments) in the Intensive Care Unit and takes care of their safety and readiness for use;

Completing Intensive Care Unit with disposable medical supplies (dressings, bandages, needles, syringes, medicinal chemicals);

Preparation of instruments for sterilization;

Storing and delivers to Roll 2 contaminated medical waste to be incinerated;

Fulfilling other orders by a physician in order to improve the patient's health or save the life of the wounded and injured.

1 | Position: Operating Room Nurse (x 2)

2 Requirements

Graduated at Medical High School with Europe Union recognized Diploma, with at least 5 years working experience in operating room filed. At English least SLP (Standard Language Profile or STANAG 6001) 1111 level (*).

Operational and International Experience. Team worker. Ability to perform activities under stressful conditions.

Wide experience in work with different kind of diseases and patients; education/training in Service/Army/Other Government Departments Medical Corps is highly recommended.

3 Responsibilities

Making the operation room ready for the surgery. Checking and making sure that all operation room equipment are in good condition and functioning properly;

Passing instruments, sponging or other items to the surgeon; taking them back after use; preparing sutures; and monitoring the sterile field to ensure that there is no contamination:

Observing patient during surgical procedure to detect possible complications and/or breaks in sterile technique; furnishing emergency equipment and supplies to prevent fatality:

Managing contaminated instruments and supplies during operation procedures to prevent spread of infection;

During operative procedure, preserving and labelling operative specimens for laboratory analysis;

Cleaning or directs cleaning and sterilization of contaminated instruments, equipment and supplies; re-sterilizing unused supplies; caring for and stores delicate surgical instruments; cleaning or assists in cleaning operating room areas and caring for and disposing of infectious and soiled linen after conclusion of each Operation;

Owing medical equipment (apparatus and instruments) in the Operating Room and takes care of their safety and readiness for use;

Working with full cooperation with other operation room staff to ensure smooth operations;

Storing and delivers to Roll 2 contaminated medical waste to be incinerated;

Fulfilling other orders by a physician in order to improve the patient's health or save the life of the wounded and injured.

1 | Position: Medical Laboratory Technician

2 Requirements

Graduated at Medical High School with Europe Union recognized Diploma, with at least 3 years working experience in medical laboratory filed. At least English SLP (Standard Language Profile or STANAG 6001) 1111 level (*).

Operational and International Experience. Team worker. Ability to perform activities under stressful conditions.

Wide experience in work with different kind of diseases and patients; education/training in Service/Army/Other Government Departments Medical Corps is highly recommended.

3 Responsibilities

Collecting patient's body fluids for lab test and analysis;

Keeping the laboratory and all equipment clean;

Analyzing and record test results in order to issue reports that utilize graphs, charts, and narratives;

Daily instrument maintenance and quality control;

Sampling testing;

Collecting and interpretation of data;

Maintaining accurate records and reporting of data;

Performing blood counts and blood tests for transfusion purposes;

Ensuring the patient of receiving compatible blood/blood components by completing blood typing, antibody screening, compatibility testing, and antibody identification procedures;

Preparing instruments for sterilization;

Owing medical equipment (apparatus and instruments) in the Laboratory and taking care of their safety and readiness for use;

Storing and delivers to Roll 2 contaminated medical waste to be incinerated;

Fulfilling other orders by a physician in order to improve the patient's health or save the life of the wounded and injured.

1 | Position: Medical X-Ray Technician

2 Requirements

Graduated at Medical High School with Europe Union recognized Diploma, with at least 3 years working experience in medical X-ray filed. At least English SLP (Standard Language Profile or STANAG 6001) 1111 level (*).

Operational and International Experience. Team worker. Ability to perform activities under stressful conditions.

Wide experience in work with different kind of diseases and patients; education/training in Service/Army/Other Government Departments Medical Corps is highly recommended.

3 Responsibilities

Performing radiographic and other diagnostic imaging procedures to assist physicians in the diagnosis of injuries and disease; prepare images for reading by physician;

Preparing patients for radiological procedures and take X-rays following established procedures for patient care and safety;

Protecting patients, yourself and staff from radiation exposure by practicing sound procedures which meet or exceed recommended industry standards;

Developing and process radiological film;

Obtain quality diagnostic radiographs as requested by Physician;

Ensuring that all equipment is in good working condition and in compliance with applicable laws and regulations; report immediately any equipment malfunctions or potentially unsafe conditions to Role 2 Manager and EUTM-S JMed;

Completing forms and maintains records, logs, and reports of work performed;

Maintaining x-ray room, stock necessary radiological supplies;

Performing routine maintenance, diagnose malfunctions, and make minor repairs on equipment, arranging for repairs as needed;

Working closely with the Physician to receive guidance and instruction for treating patients;

Fulfilling other orders by a physician in order to improve the patient's health or save the life of the wounded and injured.
