“What is my contribution to a green planet?”

**Terms and conditions for the photo competition of the
Delegation of the European Union in Ghana on Instagram 2020**

CORRIGENDUM

1. PARTICIPATION

1.1 In the framework of the Environment and Climate Week 2020, the EU Delegation to Ghana (hereinafter referred to as “the organiser”) launches a photo competition on Instagram for amateur photographers in Ghana.

The fight against climate change is one of the biggest challenges shared by humanity, regardless of where we are, as climate change knows no borders. It is one of the most important priorities of the European Union: *the “EU Green Deal”*, which aims to work towards a fair and green transition to the EU’s climate neutrality for the year 2050.

Through this competition, the images should reflect in a creative and positive way, something that symbolises the contribution of the participant to a green planet in the sense of adapting to more sustainable customs or/and bringing solutions to common challenges in terms of the preservation of the planet. The competition framework is intentionally wide to encourage creative and original support.

1.2 The main objective of the competition is the production of interesting and artistic photographs reflecting the contribution of the participant to a green planet (behavior change, sustainable innovations, choices made, etc.).

1.3 The selection and award of prizes is based solely on the work presented and in accordance with the criteria set out in these terms and conditions.

1.4 Participation in this invitation to tender is voluntary and free of charge: it does not depend on the purchase of a good or service.

1.5 The participation is exclusively online and free of charge for the participants (with the exception of costs for internet connection generated by the participants).

2. CONTEST

2.1 The invitation will be held from 19/08/2020 to 01/10/2020, with the following schedule:

Period for sending photos:	19/08/2020 – 22/09/2020
Period of competition online:	25/09/2020 – 29/09/2020
Notification of the winners:	01/10/2020

2.1. Digital files with a maximum size of 15 MB are accepted.



3. DISPATCH

- 3.1 The photographs presented may not have been awarded in previous competitions of any kind.
- 3.2 Work against decency, containing hostile or inappropriate material, shall not be admitted to the competition. The organiser has the power to remove photographs that do not comply strictly with the regulation.
- 3.3 Each participant can compete with up to three (3) photographs.
- 3.4 Participants may submit photographs in due time, running from 19/08/2020 – 22/09/2020, at 12:00 (Ghana time).
- 3.5 Photographs must be accompanied by a description, as well as the participant’s name on Instagram (if any), name and surname of the participant, age, e-mail and contact number.
- 3.6 The images must be sent to the following e-mail: euinghana.comcord@gmail.com
- 3.7 The files should be named in this way: *Namedelparticipant_ Title Title(file extension)*
- 3.8 Each job must be sent with the following data sheet completed in the email body:

Brief explanation of the work (50 words maximum): I have read and accept the terms of this invitation to tender. This work is original and unprecedented.

3.9 Once each photograph is received and after verification of compliance with the rules laid down in paragraph 3.2, the organiser shall store them for the purposes of selecting the ten (10) finalists.

4. COMPETITION

4.1 The selection process of the 10 photographs will be carried out by the organiser’s internal team (the “jury”).

When assessing the photographs, the jury will be divided in order to select the shortlisted works in accordance with the following table of scores, assigning the highest score (5) to the works that they meet to a greater extent with the above criteria. The final assessment of the individual points will determine the final rate of the work. In the event of a tie, the selection board will be able to select the ten shortlisted images.

4.2 The selection board will select ten (10) works to be submitted to the Delegation's Instagram (@europeinghana) account, in order to open the voting stage for the public on this platform, which will take place from 25/09/2020 – 29/09/2020, until 11:00 pm. Three (3) of the ten selected by the jury will be awarded.

4.3 The winners will be the three (3) authors of the participating photographs receiving more votes ('likes') on Instagram.

5. AWARDS

5.1 The award for each winning work will consist of the delivery of a diploma certifying participation and a prize. The prize will be vouchers.

- 1st – 1000 Ghana Cedis
- 2nd – 750 Ghana Cedis
- 3rd – 500 Ghana Cedis

5.2 The winners will be contacted by e-mail or by telephone by the organiser as of 01/10/2020. These results will also be publicly announced on the website of the European Union Delegation in Ghana as well as on social media. Participants not awarded will not be notified.

5.3 The winning photos will be awarded in October 2020.

5.4 The three (3) winning photographs may form part of a photographic exhibition to be performed throughout the year.

5.5 The winners will also be invited to participate in a ceremony with the EU Ambassador, where they will be able to share with our hearing on their inspiration and motivation to participate in this competition, as well as other details of the work presented.

5.6 If a prize winner does not report within the next 10 days of the notification, he will lose the right to the prize.

6. COPYRIGHT

6.1 Once a photo has been sent by the participants for the purpose of taking part in the competition, they automatically entitle the organiser to rights of unlimited use of that photo, space and time, which are not



exclusive to all types of known and unknown use, in the context of the competition.

6.2 These include in particular the right to publish on the Internet, in particular on the website of the European Union Delegation in Ghana, including its use on social media and the right of reproduction and distribution in digital and paper media, as well as the right to display the works or reproductions thereof in an expositive space in Ghana.

6.3 The participant declares that the photo submitted does not have the rights of third parties, in particular copyright, privacy rights, among other rights, and therefore allows them to freely dispose of them. The participant releases the organiser of any claim from third parties, on the grounds that this statement is not certain.

6.4 The organiser has the right to provide photographs and/or copies of photographs to other European institutions.

6.5 By using the works, they shall be appointed to their respective authors, who shall have their name and surname.

7. RESPONSIBILITY

The organiser does not assume any responsibility for any loss or incomplete submission of data by the participant.

8. PRIVACY

8.1 The personal data of the participants will be processed for the purpose of this photo competition in order to be able to identify the participants, the winners and be able to contact them for aspects linked to this competition.

8.2 The European External Action Service and the EU Delegation in Ghana process personal data in accordance with the relevant legislation. This includes Regulation (EC) No ^{45/2001} of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2000 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and the free movement of such data with its successive legislative legislation in line with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 to 25 May 2018, repealing Directive 95/46/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 October 1995.

8.4 The transfer of data to third parties for other purposes is not permitted.

8.5 The participants shall always retain the right to consult the information held by the organiser. Storage and withdrawal from the competition may be withdrawn by the participants.



9. EXCLUSION FROM THE COMPETITION

9.1 The staff of the European Delegation in Ghana as well as their family members, are excluded from participation in the competition.

9.2 The following shall also be excluded: (i) provide false personal information and data, (ii) do not comply with the conditions for participation by handing over conflicting content or prohibited (iii) to handle competition, whether by electronic means or otherwise.

10. EARLY CANCELLATION OF THE CONTEST

10.1 The organiser recalls that the availability of the competition cannot be guaranteed. The latter may be cancelled or cancelled in advance, due to external circumstances and constraints, such as: insufficient or excessive number of participants, viruses caused by viruses, external manipulation, errors in hardware or software, changes or modifications on the Instagram platform, among others, without incurring any obligation on the part of the organiser with the participants.

10.2 The organiser has the right to cancel or close the competition in advance, at any time without notice and without giving reasons.

11. Master Instagram notes and conditions

11.1 In addition to these terms and conditions, the relationship between the organiser, the participants and Instagram is governed by the conditions for participation of the platform:

11.2 All the information and data shared by the participants shall not be available to Instagram, but exclusively to the organiser.

11.3 All questions and comments on competition should be addressed only to the organiser.

12. FINAL PROVISIONS

The participants understand that no legal action can be taken against the selection process of the winner and the outcome of the selection process.
