ARMENIA



**VAHAN KHACHATRYAN
BAKER**

transformed his business with two **loans from the EU**, which helped him to install energy efficient gas stoves. Vahan's business grew and he now employs 11 people.

AZERBAIJAN



**NIGYAR KOCHARLI
BOOK SHOP OWNER**

introduced an IT system with **EU funding and expert advice from the EBRD**. Now Nigyar has a bookshop chain of 5 stores and even two book cafes.

BELARUS



**NIKOLAY KURAYEV
IT DEVELOPER**

worked together with an experienced **business adviser from the EBRD as part of EU support** to help him **expand his business**. The turnover of Nikolay's company increased by 65% in one year.

GEORGIA



**OMAR BAXTURIDZE
DENTIST**

received a loan to buy more space with a better location for his dental practice. Now, the number of clients has increased. Omar plans to add two dental chairs in his new surgery.

REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA



**ANDRIAN DAVIDESCU
WINE PRODUCER**

received **EU funding** and advice from **EBRD experts** to improve the **marketing** of his wines. Now Andrian exports his wine to more than eight countries.

UKRAINE

FARMER**

received a series of **loans from the EU to try new crops** and acquire **farming equipment**. Now Sergei cultivates 1000 hectares and employs seven people.
