ERASMUS+ Scholarship

WHAT is Erasmus+ Scholarship?

Erasmus+, or Erasmus Plus, is the European Union (EU) funded programme for education, training, youth and sport. This brochure focuses only on Erasmus+ scholarship opportunities for master's degree students, doctoral candidates and scholars who are interested in studying, teaching or conducting research in Europe.



WHAT types of scholarships are available?

Types of Scholarships offered:

1. **Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree (EMJMD)** - an integrated master's programme delivered by a consortium of higher education institutions from different countries which lead to the award of mutualy recognised joint, double or multiple mater's degree.

2. **Erasmus Mundus Joint Doctorate (EMJD)** - an integrated doctoral programme delivered by a consortium of higher education institutions from different countries which lead to the award of mutualy recognised joint, double or multiple doctoral degree.

3. **Scholars** who want to teach or carry out research and scholarly work at an institution participating in the EMJMD up to a maximum of three months.

Eligibility

Master's Degree Student or Doctoral Candidate

- A third-country* national
- Not a resident of any of the EU Member States
- Has not carried out his or her main activity (studies, work, etc.) for more than a total of 12 months over the last five years in any of the EU Member States
- Has completed the relevant degree before the enrolment deadline in the EMJMD or EMJD programme

Scholar

- > A third-country scholar enrolled in any third-country higher education institution
- > Not a resident of any of the EU Member States
- A scholar enrolled in a European higher education institution which act as a full partner institution for the purpose of contributing to the joint programme
- Has outstanding academic and/or professional experience

*Indonesia is in the third-country category

ERASMUS Degree

1. Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree (EMJMD): Follow an entire or multiple degree(s) in Europe

- An EMJMD is an integrated study programme offered by a Consortium of universities.
- An EMJMD leads to the award of a recognised joint, double or multiple degree(s).
- An EMJMD consists of 60, 90 or 120 European
 Credit Transfer System (ECTS) credits at masters level, thus lasting from one to two academic years.

WHAT is a Consortium? A Consortium is a group of at least

A Consortium is a group of at least three higher education institutions from three different European countries which has been selected by the European Commission (EC) – the executive body of the EU – to offer an EMJMD or EMJD.

The EMJMD covers a wide range of academic disciplines: agricultural and forestry sciences, business studies and management sciences, communication and information sciences, education and teacher training, engineering and technology, humanities, law etc.

2. Erasmus Mundus Joint Doctorate (EMJD): Undertake your research in Europe

- An EMJD is an integrated training and research programme offered by a Consortium of universities.
- Doctoral candidates will undertake training/ research periods in at least two of the European countries represented in the Consortium.
- The candidates must spend at least two thirds of their doctoral programme in Europe for the period covered by the fellowship.
- The candidates must complete the training and research programme within a maximum period of four years, although the EMJD fellowship will cover a maximum of three years.
- > An EMJD leads to the award of a recognised joint, double or multiple degree(s).

Starting from 2014 onwards, this Doctoral Programme – the EMJD – and additional doctoral fellowships are available under the **Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions**, which form part of the EU's **Horizon 2020** programme for research and innovation. WHAT does the scholarship cover?

- For master's degree student and doctoral candidates: tuition fees and participation costs (including insurance coverage), travel costs, installation costs and monthly allowance.
- > For scholars: living allowance (including travel costs).
- > The fund are paid through the Consortium.

Master's Degree Student	€ 24,000 per student for a one-year course € 48,000 per student for a two-year course
Doctoral Candidate	Travel: € 7,500 Non-Laboratory based: €10,800 (36 months) Laboratory based: € 21,600 (36 months) Employment contract € 2,800/month or Stipends € 1,400/month
Scholar	€ 14,800 per scholar for a three-month period

HOW and WHEN to apply?

- Indonesians interested in an Erasmus+ Scholarship have to apply directly to the Consortium offering the particular EMJMD or EMJD programme of their choice. The application period is usually opened in September or October, for courses starting the following academic year.
- Application procedures and deadlines vary between courses.

IS the scholarship applicable for other degree programmes?

No. The scholarships are exclusively reserved for undertaking Erasmus+ joint programmes (EMJMD and EMJD). In other words, it is not applicable for students, doctoral candidates and scholars who have been accepted by other master or doctoral degree programmes in Europe or elsewhere in the world.

QUICK STEPS to apply for an Erasmus+ Scholarship

1) Review all the Master (EMJMD) or Doctorate (EMJD) programmes offering Erasmus+ Scholarships for the next academic year: http://bit.ly/beasiswaEU

2) Select the course which you are interested in and access its website to obtain specific details, such as course description, prerequisites, the application process, forms and deadlines.

3) Apply directly to the Consortium via its website.



The Consortium proposes a list of successful applicants to the EC Headquarters in Brussels for final approval (by the end of February).

The EC confirms the selection and assigns the grants (by the end of March).

Following the deadline for application, the Consortium will select the applicant on the basis of the CV, study and academic merits, motivation.



The Consortium will notify applicants if they have been accepted for the course and if they have been awarded a scholarship (usually in May).
