The application must contain the following information for being accepted in the vendor's list (see enclosed form);

- identification of the vendor (supplier, service provider or contractor) indicating name, business address (full address of registration of the firm, if applicable), telephone and e-mail;
- indication of the tenders where the vendor wants to be included by filling enclosed form
- contracts subject of these tenders shall not exceed 144 000 € for services and supplies or 5 548 000 € for works (until 31/12/2020)
- the place of delivery for these contracts will be the EU Delegation to Thailand, addressed as above.
- for every new supply, service or work's contract to be awarded, the Delegation may invite those vendors included in the relevant list or sub-list to submit a tender.
- Inclusion on the list entails no obligation on the part of the Delegation concerning the award of the contract. The use of this list is not compulsory.
- Contracts exceeding 144 000 € will be subject of an ex-ante publication. Vendors interested in participating to these tenders must reply to such publication. The inclusion in a vendors' list gives no automatic right to participate as candidate for these contracts above 144 000 €.

- Processing your reply involves the recording and processing of personal and company data (such as your name and address). Such data will be processed pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data. Unless indicated otherwise, your replies to the questions and any personal data requested are required to evaluate your future tenders in accordance with the specifications of the invitations to tender and will be processed solely for that purpose by the Delegation.

- The vendors' list is valid until 31 December 2018. Interested parties may submit an application at any time prior to the last three months of validity of the list.
- Interested parties may apply for one or more of the contracts included in the lists of contracts and sub-lists mentioned below. As mentioned in §2 above, the application must clearly indicate the lists and/or sub-list of interest of which the candidates will be part of.
- Other EU Delegations may publish similar vendors' lists. Interested parties must reply individually to each publication as each EU Delegation is a separate and independent contracting authority.
