Gouvernement du Canada Immunization is one of the most cost effective public health interventions. It prevents currently 2-3 million deaths per year and is our most reliable front-line defence against infectious disease. The progress we have made is threatened by complacency coupled with misunderstanding and misinformation about vaccines that has undermined public trust, resulting in outbreaks of vaccine-preventable diseases among communities or individuals who have decided to delay a decision to vaccinate or decided not to vaccinate despite the availability of vaccines and vaccination services
