JOINT ACTIONS

#TeamEurope contributed **USD 998 million** to **COVAX Advance Market Commitment** to reserve and accelerate vaccination for people of 92 low and middle income economies, of which **Viet Nam** is one of the eligible countries. https://www.gavi.org/gavi-covax-amc

Over EUR 800 million to put an end to the spread of the virus and to avoid spill-over effects on social stability and security in **ASEAN**, of which **EUR 20 million** allocated to WHO to strengthen the health system capacity and to respond to the coronavirus and future diseases in South East Asia and **EUR 5 million** to support the **ASEAN COVID-19 Response Fund**.

To **off-set the impact** of the COVID-19 pandemic in **Viet Nam**, a budget support grant of **EUR**19 million was transferred to the State Treasury to provide additional fiscal space to implement policies to address socio-economic consequences of the crisis.

EUR 1.2 million grant support to implement two NGO projects that support vulnerable communities in Viet Nam to respond to COVID-19 impacts.





Support to Public Health in Viet Nam

EUR 32.8 million from **Italy** for three projects in the cities of Ca Mau, Tay Ninh and Nui Thanh (Quang Nam province) to improve urban sanitation conditions through rehabilitation of drainage systems and realization of waste water treatment systems

EUR 12.3 million from **Italy** to support the improvement of health systems in the provinces of Thua Thien Hue, Quang Nam, Quang Tri; and support to the Hue University of Medicine and Pharmacy (HUMP) to strengthen preventive and curative health services and upgrading some departments of HUMP Hospital, including the center for surveillance and control on respiratory infections named after Carlo Urbani.

EUR 123,000 from **Germany** for a TVET programme on setting up distance learning/activities related to COVID-19





Support to Public Health in Viet Nam

Cooperation between Pasteur Institute and Viet Nam's National Lung Hospital on protection of health care workers against coronavirus via Bacillus Calmette and Guérin vaccination (BCG+).

AFD's ECOMORE programme is implemented by the Pasteur Institute to meet the demands of the national reference laboratories. Through a coordination mechanism, the project effectively contributes to intra-regional cooperation in the health sector. https://ecomore.org/

Cooperation between France's University of Montpellier and University of Public Health in Hai Phong to evaluate the impact of COVID-19 lockdown measures on HIV and HCV risk behaviours and access to prevention and care for people who inject drugs (DRIVE-COVID)

Cooperation between the French Healthcare Vietnam and Pham Ngoc Thach University to educate Intensive Care Unit (ICU) staff on management of COVID-19 patients. Adaptation of Decathlon's integral snorkeling mask to a wide range of ventilators through the development of adaptors and focus on non-invasive ventilation alternatives.
