



## 'Wave of Change' European Union Pacific Art Competition

### Terms and conditions

1. The Delegation of the European Union for the Pacific (hereafter "**the Delegation**") is conducting a competition called the "Wave of Change" European Union Pacific Art Competition (hereafter "**the Competition**").

2. These terms and conditions apply to the Competition and by submitting your entry you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions. Any entry that does not comply with these terms and conditions may be deemed invalid and ineligible to win a prize.

3. The Competition is open from 9am on Thursday, 10 December 2020 FJT until 4pm on Thursday, 5 February 2021 (hereafter "**the Competition Period**"). Any entry received after the expiry of the Competition Period will be deemed invalid. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected entries. The Delegation reserves the right to extend the Competition Period at its discretion.

### Entry

4. The Competition is open to all primary and high school students aged 8 years and older in the 13 Pacific islands countries covered by the Delegation (Cook Islands, Fiji, Kiribati, Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Nauru, Niue, Palau, Samoa, Solomon Islands, Tonga, Tuvalu and Vanuatu) as well as the three Overseas Countries and Territories in the Pacific (French Polynesia, New Caledonia and Wallis and Futuna).

5. Entrants must:

- a. Read these Terms and Conditions;



- b. Create a piece of visual artwork (painting, drawing, sculpture, collage etc. — but no photography) that embraces the theme “Wave of Change,” and considers the question for your age group (see point d);
  - c. Upload a high-quality scan or image of the artwork through the entry form;
    - i. Publish the photo on Facebook, Instagram and/or Twitter using the hashtags **#WaveofChangePacific** and **#EU4Women** and tag @EUpasifika to be considered for the ‘public choice’ prize.
  - d. Prepare and submit a short statement of 100 words or less that describes your artwork and answers the question below for your age category:
    - i. **8-11 years:** Which woman or girl inspires me the most, and why?
    - ii. **12-15 years:** What can I do to increase respect for women and girls?
    - iii. **16+ years:** How can I end violence against women and girls?
6. Entry into the Competition is free.
7. Entrants may only enter the Competition with one submission.
8. Any entries deemed by the Delegation to be inappropriate or offensive will be ineligible to win a prize and excluded from the Competition.
9. By submitting an entry, each entrant accepts and acknowledges that:
- a. they have read and accepted these terms and conditions;
  - b. all details provided with their entry are true and accurate;
  - c. the entrant owns or has the right to submit their artwork for entry to this Competition;



- d. the entrant has obtained consent and permission from their responsible parent/guardian to enter the Competition;
- e. their entry, and the Delegation's use of their entry, will not:
  - i. infringe any person's copyright or other intellectual property rights;
  - ii. infringe any person's privacy rights or any applicable privacy laws; or
  - iii. breach any other laws.

10. The Entrant grants the Delegation a perpetual, royalty-free licence to use, reproduce, publish and communicate their entry, including a right to sublicense it to other parties (including posting on the Delegation's social media accounts and publication in a book produced by the Delegation), in any format for the purpose of the Competition and for the Delegation's marketing and promotional purposes.

## Judging and Prizes

11. The Competition is a game of skill. The Delegation will judge all valid entries received within the Competition Period and select winners based on the ability to encapsulate the theme 'Wave of Change' and consider the question for their age group through their artwork and short statement ("**Prize Winner**"). This Competition is not a game of chance and chance plays no part in selecting the Prize Winners.

12. The Delegation will select up to 6 (six) prize winners to win a prize.

13. A 'public choice' Prize Winner will be determined amongst entrants who have shared their artwork through social media platforms (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram) using the hashtags #WaveOfChangePacific and #EU4Women, with the prize being awarded to the entrant whose post has received the largest cumulative number of 'likes' across all platforms.



14. The prizes are as follows:

1. **First prize** for each age category consists of a prize pack valued at EUR 100, which includes: a school backpack, assorted stationery, plus a selection of equipment from the category of the Prize Winner's choice (art supplies, sport supplies or school supplies);
2. **Second prize** for each age category consists of a prize pack valued at EUR 50, which includes: a school backpack, assorted stationery, plus a selection of equipment from the category of the Prize Winner's choice (art supplies, sport supplies or school supplies);;
3. The '**Public choice**' prize consists of a prize pack valued at EUR 50, which includes: a school backpack, assorted stationery, plus a selection of equipment from the category of the Prize Winner's choice (art supplies, sport supplies or school supplies).

15. The prizes cannot be redeemed for cash.

16. The Prize Winners will be notified within 7 (seven) days after the end of the Competition Period via the email address and/or phone number provided in the entry form. Prize Winners will also be published on the Delegation's website and social media accounts for 30 days following the closing of the competition.

17. The decisions of the Delegation regarding Prize Winners are final and will be binding on each entrant. No correspondence or communications will be entered into. If, after reasonable efforts, a Prize Winner cannot be contacted, cannot accept a prize or is deemed to be ineligible to enter the Competition, the Delegation reserves the right to select a different Prize Winner.

18. If any event prevents or hinders the Competition or the Delegation's ability to deliver a prize, the Delegation may, at its



absolute discretion, cancel the Competition, select another Prize Winner or provide a similar prize of equivalent value.

19. The Delegation may refuse to award a prize, or seek its recovery, in the event of the relevant Entrant's fraud, dishonesty, or non-entitlement under, or breach of, these terms and conditions. In the event of a dispute concerning the identity of the person who submits an entry, the entry will be deemed to have been submitted by the owner of the social media account on which the entry is posted.

### Personal information

20. Each Entrant consents to the Delegation using the Entrant's name, country and age supplied or connected with their entry for the purposes of the Competition and for the Delegation's marketing and promotional purposes.

### Disclaimer and liability

22. The Delegation accepts no responsibility for invalid, misdirected, lost or delayed entries, any incorrect or inaccurate information, any equipment or technical error, or for any defect in, theft, destruction, unauthorised access to or alteration of any entry.

23. To the extent permitted by law, the Delegation will not be liable for any injury, damages, expenses, or loss whatsoever (whether direct or indirect) to persons or property as a result of any person entering the Competition or accepting or using any prize, including — without limitation — non-receipt of any prize.



24. To the extent permitted by law, all warranties in respect of the prize, whether express, implied, statutory or otherwise, are excluded. To the extent such warranties cannot be excluded by law but liability can lawfully be limited, liability is limited at the Delegation's option to replacing the prize or the cost of replacing the prize or acquiring an equivalent item.

25. Each entrant releases Facebook, Instagram and Twitter from any and all liability for any loss, damage or injury arising out of or in relation to the Competition.
