

Ioannis Giogkarakis-Argyropoulos has been the Ambassador and Head of the Delegation of the European Union to PNG since September 2015.

He has previously served in the Delegation of the European Commission to Senegal, The Gambia and Cape Verde, Ethiopia and Djibouti.

Ioannis first served in PNG as Adviser, Second Secretary from 1992 to 1996.

He has been Head of Sector and Head of Unit for a number of European Commission programmes. Ioannis holds Masters degrees in Business Administration and Engineering, and was a site engineer in the private sector before joining the European Commission.

Abstract

Since the creation of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea in 1975, the European Union has been building a solid relationship with the Government, and is today a trusted and valuable partner, accompanying the people of Papua New Guinea in the political, social and economic development of their country. This year 2017, the European Union and Papua New Guinea celebrate 40 years of this partnership.
